The Edge Foundation's '[Apprenticeships Work](#)' campaign is targeted at SMEs to encourage more small businesses to take on apprentices. Edge knows young people's interest in apprenticeships is growing, while employers are facing skills challenges that limit growth so are calling for Government to expand support for SMEs and opportunities for young people. Two new reports help form the campaign, which show the need to create a 'one-stop' apprenticeship application system and support SMEs through apprenticeship brokerage services and sector-specific advice.

The Careers & Enterprise Company has published [Gatsby Benchmark results](#) for the 2024/25 academic year, based on Compass returns from 4,863 state schools in England – the largest number to date and representing 94% of all schools and colleges. Highlighting further improvements in engagement and achievement of benchmarks and concerns around some benchmarks being harder to achieve than others and ‘uneven’ progress between different types of institution, the results make interesting reading.
