Government launches national conversation on SEND



Department for Education

The government acts on their commitment to put parent's experiences at the heart of SEND reform through a new public engagement campaign. The government is committed to creating a SEND system that stands the test of time, ensuring that every child receives the support they need. Councils are given £3bn to create thousands more spaces for SEND pupils



The government has announced that 50,000 school places will be created for SEND students from £3 billion of funding. Some of the funding will go towards creating school places across the country in mainstream schools so that SEND children are not expected to travel far for their education. The remaining amount of funding may be used to create breakout spaces for children who may need more support or for rooms to support children with autism and ADHD who find a classroom environment overstimulating.
